

| Molecular Weight  | Recombinant protein product has a calculated molecular mass of 40 kDa. Due to the abundant glycosylation, it migrates as approximately 52 kDa protein bands in SDS-PAGE under DTT, beta-mercaptoethanol reducing conditions. |

#### **SDS-PAGE Image**

Figure 1. Deglycosylation analysis of purified recombinant proteins. Product was either untreated (Lane 2) or treated with deglycosylation enzymes under native (Lane 3) or denaturing (Lane 4) conditions. Deglycosylation treatment resulted in a mobility shift, indicating that the untreated protein (Lane 2) was glycosylated. Lane 1, protein ladder (kDa).



## Shipping

The product is shipped with ice packs. Upon arrival, immediately store it at the temperature recommended below.

### Storage/Stability

- Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
- Upon arrival, the liquid protein may be stored for 2 weeks at 4°C.
- For long term storage, it is recommended to store at -20°C or -80°C in appropriate aliquots.
- Generally, the shelf life is up to 6 months from the date of receipt at -20°C or -80°C under sterile conditions.
